

# Francis Howell Vikings Choir Fundraising by working Concessions Booth at Family Arena Events

#### Uniform:

- *Preferred* blue jeans or khaki pants with a blue, grey, or white shirt (preferably a Francis Howell shirt if you have one)
  - black or blue pants are also acceptable
  - Shorts or capri-style pants are not permitted
  - Family Arena polo shirts may be provided and used during a volunteer shift, but these shirts MUST remain at the Arena and returned at the end of the shift
  - The Vikings Choir Parent Board will provide a blue Choirs apron for each crew member. The Parent Leader is responsible to ensure all aprons are collected at the end of the shift and returned to the Choir Treasurer with the donation jars (see below).
- Shoes must be enclosed toe for everyone's safety (sandals, open toe, high-heels, slip-on or 'mule' style footwear are <u>not permitted</u>)
- Hats must be worn at all times by all workers, preferably a Francis Howell hat (otherwise a blue or black hat). Hats should be clean and presentable. If a volunteer does not have a hat, a hairnet can be issued by the Family Arena to wear instead.
- Any volunteer not meeting uniform requirements will be asked to leave and return with proper attire. If the volunteer doesn't return with proper attire the entire group will be deducted for a staffing shortage
- Volunteers can find their allocated positions by the reference list on the bulletin board located inside Gate 5 (see Parking)

#### Donation Jars:

• The Vikings Choir Parent Board will provide donation jars to be placed by each register in the concessions booth. The Parent Leader is responsible to ensure all donations and donation jars are collected at the end of the shift and returned to the Choir Treasurer.

### Parking:

• Park in the employee section on the north side of the arena and enter through Gate 5 (indicated by yellow arrow on the map on the next page)
